Using the MensaCard

- The MensaCard is needed to pay in any Mensa or coffeebar of the **studierendenWERK BERLIN**, cash is **not** accepted!
- The MensaCard needs to be **pre**-charged at the charging station.

 Charging stations can be found in all mensas (usually before the entrance in the foyer).

Charging is only possible with cash. In Hardenbergstrasse there are two ATMs available next to the charging station in the foyer on the ground floor.

The charging station at Hardenbergstrasse is accessible until 18.00h during the week; the other stations are only accesible during opening hours of the respective Mensa.

- As guests of the university you have to pay the prices of the 3rd category, i.e. the price on the far right which is usually listed as follows: \in 1,00 / 2,00 / **3,00**
- Special diet information is provided on the menu by means of the following graphics, e.g. for vegeterian or vegan options.



The MensaCard **must** be returned to the registration desk. A box will be available where your MensaCard can be returned easily.

Note that we will **not** be able to reimburse you the money charged onto the card. Thus make sure to use all of the credit on the MensaCard.
